Resumes please; headshots not required; no appointment necessary, but please arrive as close to 7 as possible. Readings from the play will be provided. Rehearsals start Thursday, May 11.

Michael Wells, 30's or 40's - educator (NOTE: Michael spends 90% of the play in a blindfold and handcuffs; Michael will also be required to grow unkempt hair and beard - he has been held prisoner for over 1 year)

Lainie Wells, 30's or 40's - educator

Both Michael and Lainie have multiple, long monologues. They are married and deeply in love.

Walker Harris, any age, reporter

Ellen van Oss, 40's or 50's, representative of the State Department (think "I'm from the government and I'm here to help you...")

Walker and Ellen are not small roles. Both have lots of stage time.

All roles are open and unpaid

Tentative rehearsal dates: May 11, 15, 16, 25, (3 week rehearsal break to learn lines while Director travels), June 19, 20, 22, 26, 27, 29, July rehearsals: July 6, 9, 10, 11, 13
All rehearsals at Tualatin Heritage Center; Additional rehearsals may be scheduled as needed. Performances July 14-23; Fri/Sat @ 7:30; Sunday @ 2

Synopsis: An American teacher is held hostage in a dark room after being captured in Beirut. His wife holds a vigil for him in an empty room in their house outside DC. Michael dictates unsent letters to his wife from his cell. Lainie vies between Walker, a journalist intent to tell her story to the public and Ellen, a State Department official who wants to keep her quiet. When Lainie finds out that Walker has written a story about her without her permission, she has to come to terms with her grief in a more public setting and has to reconcile what impact telling her story to the public will have. As events in the Middle East spin out of everyone's control, the characters try to do their best to manage the situation to bring Michael back to the United States, but everyone has their own interests at stake.

Two Rooms navigates the real and imagined worlds of the four characters. As they interact with one another in their minds, their imagined conversations affect their real life actions.

Last month, we laughed as we read *The Game's Afoot*. This month the Play Selection Committee of Mask & Mirror invites you to a dramatic reading of *The Runner Stumbles*, a script based on a true story that examines a mysterious death and the tragic consequences for a range of characters. This play has been submitted for possible inclusion in the coming season. After we read the play, we hold a short discussion about suitability for Mask & Mirror and our audiences.

***The Runner Stumbles* by Milan Stitt**

A young nun has died under mysterious circumstances in a remote parish in northern Michigan, and her superior, Father Rivard, has been charged with her murder. The action alternates between interrogations, testimony and scenes from the past which reveal that Father Rivard, who had been banished to the small, up-country parish, fell in love with Sister Rita; and when circumstances forced her to move into the rectory with him, his anguish became unbearable. Their relationship, inevitably, spelled tragedy, but not until the explosive and surprising climax of the play is the full extent of their sacrifice made clear and the identity of the murderer revealed.

Characters: No specific ages or character descriptions, but Sister Rita and Louise should be on the young side and Mrs. Shandig is older.


Gary Romans is Weller Martin in *The Gin Game* at Gallery Theatre, McMinnville, April 14-May 6. Joe Silva directs.
