Yes, it's "Tony and Tona's Wedding", opening Sept 8th at the Tigard United Methodist Church. This is going to be a great show - but with fewer than twenty seats left (out of 640) as of this writing, it may be too late to get a seat by the time you read this... **(it is too late - all performances SOLD OUT! - ed.)**

For those who haven't seen this show, "Tony and Tina's Wedding" (or "TnT" as we call it) is partially structured, in that the same series of events happens each night. But it's also highly improvised, which each actor "inhabiting" their character, mingling and conversing with the crowd and each other throughout the show. In that sense, it's a new and different show each night.

Our directors/producers (Gary Romans and Kathryn Stevens) have assembled a cast of over twenty, plus a live band, for this eight show run. Rehearsals have been an exciting mix of the expected (learning lines and blocking) and the new (improvisation games, character exploration and more). Many of our actors have some amount of improv experience, and some have quite extensive experience. For some, however, it's their first time.

The show runs roughly three hours each night, including a pasta dinner catered by Davidson's Casual Dining, along with cake and a (non-alcoholic) "champagne toast". You can dance with your friends and cast members to our live band. You'll laugh along with the crazy antics of the Vitale and Nunzio families. And, yes, it will be "better than "Cats"". We await your RSVP...

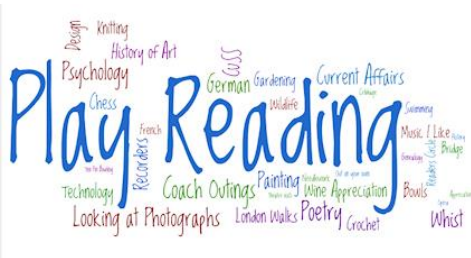

Time to pay your dues!

Once a year we ask that you show your support for our organization and demonstrate your affiliation in a financial way. Yup, folks, it's that time!

Our dues year begins on September 1 and ends August 31. To maintain or establish your status as a Member in Good Standing (MIGS), it's time once again to get out your wallet, checkbook, or credit card and computer or phone (see below how to pay online!) and support the organization financially. These dues are only \$20 per year, (\$30 per couple or family,) and they all go to operational costs to mount our productions and activities. If you might want to run for a Board position next spring, you must get your payment in by December 31st of this year.

As a Member in Good Standing (MIGS) you can:

- *Proudly wear your gen-u-ine plastic M&M name badge,
- *Buy discounted tickets to our shows,
- *Get a 10% discount on our promotional merchandise, (Have you seen the ball caps?)
- *Get preferential seating to our shows,
- *Get free coffee or tea at our shows,
- *Publicize your acting or tech gigs in our newsletter,
- *Participate in any special social activities,
- *Vote in elections or on any issues brought to the full membership,
- *Run for office after six months of being a Member in Good Standing.
