Director Linda Talluto will direct this show with two separate casts of two talented actors each: Cast 1 will be Peter Bolger and Rebecca Rowland Hines, and cast 2 will be Ron Harman and Virginia Kincaid.

The play's two characters are a man and a woman who exchange letters, but not marriage vows, in a complicated friendship lasting 50 years. Poignant, romantic, and frequently funny, their correspondence follows a bittersweet path of marriage, children, divorce, and missed opportunities.
