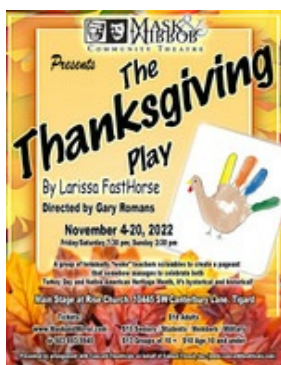

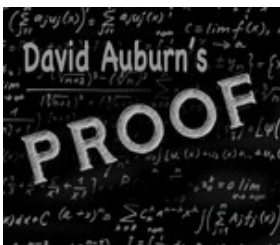

*Member in Good Standing - Amelia Michaels

Amelia Michaels is an Oregonian who moved to Seattle but returned in 2017. She says she'd “been here for about ten days before showing up to auditions for (Mask & Mirror's) ***Musical Comedy Murders of 1940***. I think I've been involved with at least one show per season since then.”

But Amelia's been on stage since childhood. "I've been dancing since kindergarten; my first dance recital was as a book in ***Beauty and the Beast - Hamlet***, to be precise. Then at age ten, I was one of 28 kids trying out for a chorus of 30 in ***Joseph and His Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat***."

What drew her to the stage? "I fell in love with the rehearsal process and the magic of a show coming together from the bare bones of a first read-through."

When asked about her favorite roles, Amelia says she's "drawn to physically active roles or really juicy, well-written scripts with twists and turns. My top three are *The Furies* in ***The Eumenides*** (Hendrix College), *Lorraine* in ***The Receptionist*** (M&M Unmasked) and *Charlotte* in ***Charlotte's Web*** (Beaverton Civic Theatre)."

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Amelia is currently advising the cast of ***The Thanksgiving Play*** as the Yoga Coach and will be starting rehearsals soon as Catherine, in *Mask & Mirror*'s first play in this year's *Unmasked* series, ***Proof***.

“The *Unmasked* series holds a special place in my heart - I'm thankful that there is a space for edgier dramas and lesser known shows without having to drive into Portland.”

Proof – especially her part – has lots of dialog to remember. When asked what procedure she uses to learn all of those lines, Amelia advises to start early! “I've started working on them already! I say them out loud and read the entire script, not just my own scenes. Every day, no exceptions. After the bulk of the work is done in rote memorization, I run my lines while doing other physical activities like chores or dishes - anything that's moving my body and asking my brain and mouth to work at the same time.”
